



# Commercial Driver License Document Requirements for U.S. Immigrants

You must bring specific forms of proof of identification, Social Security, and residential address.

## ONE Primary Identification

Original or certified copy. No photocopies.

- Valid Alien Registration receipt card, (Green card, Form I-551)
- I-797 with customer's A-number, stating the customer has been granted asylum
- I-551 stamp in passport or on I-94
- Immigration Judge's Order with the customer's A-number granting asylum
- I-797 or another form from the Bureau of Citizenship & Immigration Services with the customer's A-number, stating the customer's application for Refugee status is approved

## ONE Social Security Number

Must contain full social security number

- Original Social Security Card
- W-2 Form
- Pay Stub
- SSA-1099
- Non-SSA-1099

**Name Change: If you have legally changed your name by marriage or court order, you must have your name changed on your U.S. Citizen and Immigration Services (USCIS) documents.**

## TWO Proofs of Florida Residential Address - All proofs must be in your name Must present one proof from List A and one from List B, or two proofs from List A

Electronic notices are accepted. Please print & bring with you.

### List A

- A recent lease or rental agreement for the residence with a term of 6 months or greater in the name of the driver
- Florida vehicle registration or title
- Florida vessel registration or title
- Current homeowner's insurance policy or bill
- Current utility bill
- Recent cellular or landline telephone bill (must be dated within the last 30-60 days)
- Recent internet service provider bill (must be dated within the last 30-60 days)
- Latest property tax bill
- Mortgage deed for property in Florida

### List B

- Latest W-2 form or 1099 form (must be dated within the last 6 months)
- Recent bank statement (must be dated within the last 60 days)
- Recent credit card statement (must be dated within the last 60 days)
- Latest military orders or documents
- Recent pay stub (must be dated within the last 60 days)
- Recent official government documents (must be dated within the last 60 days)

Applicants unable to provide a proof of residential address from list A can provide a Declaration of Domicile filed with the Clerk of the Circuit Court AND one proof of residential address document from List B.

### Important Notes:

- CLP & CDL applicants **cannot** use a Certification of Address (HSMV-71120) for licensure.
- CLP & CDL applicants upgrading from a Class E or ID card must resubmit acceptable proof of residential address.
- CLP & CDL applicants must present proof that they are a Florida resident. Please visit [hillstax.org](http://hillstax.org) to see a list of valid examples.

**VETERANS** requesting a veteran's designation on their license must present proof of an honorable discharge such as DD Form 2, Military Retired ID Card, DD Form 214 (copy 4, members copy), 100% Disabled Veteran Card or a verification of service letter from the VA.
