SUBJECT: Temporary Protected Status - Haiti	

Overview:

Temporary Protected Status (TPS) is a temporary status provided to nationals of specifically designated countries that are confronting an ongoing armed conflict, environmental disaster, or extraordinary and temporary conditions. The Secretary of Homeland Security has the discretion of deciding when a country's eligibility is discontinued or extended.

Details:

The Secretary of Homeland Security partially vacated the June 4, 2024, decision to extend the TPS designation for Haiti. The designation for Haiti will remain August 3, 2025. Documents with an expiration date of February 3, 2026, will be accepted; however, the customer will only be entitled to an issuance through August 3, 2025. Those that do not meet the requirements listed in the ADT are not entitled to issuance or a 60-day permit.

Required documents for processing all TPS nationals for a driver license or identification card is located under the Temporary Protected Status (TPS) section of the Acceptable Documents Table (ADT).
