SUBJECT: CORRECTION: Length of Issuance - Temporarily Admitted

Foreign Nationals (Non-Immigrant) Credentials

Overview:

Pursuant to F.S. 322.051, 322.08, and 322.18, Florida driver license renewals and identification cards issued to temporarily admitted foreign nationals are valid until the expiration date of their U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) document, not to exceed one year.

Details:

Effective immediately, temporarily admitted foreign nationals are only entitled to issuance through the expiration date on their legal presence document, not to exceed a year. If the customer's immigration documents do not have an expiration date, then the expiration date of the credential shall not exceed one year.
