SUBJECT: Temporary Protected Status – South Sudan

Overview:

Temporary Protected Status (TPS) is a temporary status provided to nationals of specifically designated countries that are confronting an ongoing conflict, environmental disaster, or extraordinary and temporary conditions. The Secretary of Homeland Security has the discretion of deciding when a country's eligibility is discontinued or extended.

Details:

The Secretary of Homeland Security has extended TPS status for beneficiaries of South Sudan through November 3, 2025.

Customers with an Employment Authorization Document (EAD) (Category code A12 & C19) with the expiration date of May 3, 2025, or November 3, 2023, are automatically extended to November 3, 2025. Required documents for processing all TPS nationals for driver licenses or identification cards are located under the Temporary Protected Status section of the Acceptable Documents Table (ADT).
