SUBJECT: Temporary Protected Status Termination - Cameroon	

Overview:

Temporary Protected Status (TPS) is a temporary status provided to nationals of specifically designated countries that are confronting an ongoing conflict, environmental disaster, or extraordinary and temporary conditions. The Secretary of Homeland Security has the discretion of deciding when a country's eligibility is discontinued or extended.

Details:

The Secretary of Homeland Security has terminated the designation of Cameroon for Temporary Protected Status. The current designation is set to expire on August 4, 2025.

Customers with an approved I-821 or Employment Authorization Document (EAD) card with the expiration date of June 7, 2025, will only be eligible for issuance through August 4, 2025, after which other valid lawful presence documents will be required. Those that do not meet the requirements listed in the Acceptable Document Table (ADT) are not entitled to issuance or a 60-day permit.
