SUBJECT: Temporary Protected Status - Haiti	

Overview:

Temporary Protected Status (TPS) is a temporary status provided to nationals of specifically designated countries that are confronting an ongoing conflict, environmental disaster, or extraordinary and temporary conditions. The Secretary of Homeland Security has the discretion of deciding when a country's eligibility is discontinued or extended.

Details:

The United States District Court has ordered an injunction of the termination of Temporary Protected Status for Haiti. Until litigation is complete, customers are entitled to issuance until **February 3, 2026**.

Customers with a valid Employment Authorization Document (EAD) card or pending/approved I-821, are automatically extended through February 3, 2026, after which alternative valid lawful presence documents will be required. Those that do not meet the requirements listed in the Acceptable Document Table (ADT) are not entitled to issuance or a 60-day temporary permit.
